Junior Editors will enjoy flexibility in their workload allowing to fit their schedules.

### SELECTION CRITERIA

The ideal applicants are PhD candidates and postgraduate students with significant knowledge and interest in competition law or regulation. Applicants should demonstrate an interest in YARS focus, a very good command of the English language (B2-C2 level), and the ability to manage the workload within set time frames.
